VIP ticket provides a week of dinners

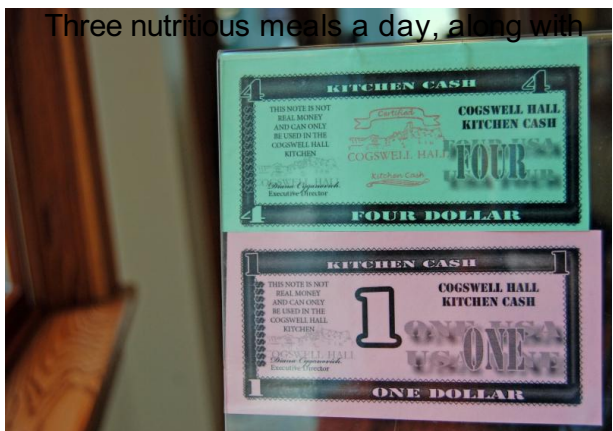

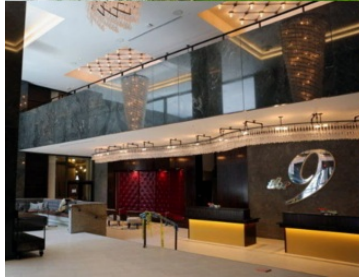
